**RECONSTITUTION OF THE BARANGAY HEALTH WORKERS
REGISTRATION AND ACCREDITATION COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and provide conditions of health empowerment, where each individual has access to information and services that will bring about health and well-being;

WHEREAS, the institutionalization of an effective program for Barangay Health Workers (BHWs) shall undeniably strengthen the primary health care services of the Municipality;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Loon recognizes the crucial role of the BHWs as frontliners in the delivery of primary health care services;

WHEREAS, in order for the BHWs to be entitled to benefits and incentives, he/she shall register with the Barangay Health Workers Registration and Accreditation Committee (BHW-RAC);

WHEREAS, the Barangay Health Workers Registration and Accreditation Committee that was created by virtue of Executive Order No. 15 issued on May 17, 2018 needs to be reconstituted;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered and by virtue of the authority vested upon me under the Local Government Code and other existing laws, I, Elvi Peter L. Relampagos, mayor of the Municipality of Loon, Bohol, do hereby declare and order the following:

Section 1. Composition. - There shall be created in the Local Government Unit of Loon a Barangay Health Workers Registration and Accreditation Committee (BHW-RAC) to be composed of the following:

Section 2. Duties and Responsibilities of the BHW-RAC. - The BHW-RAC is tasked to facilitate the registration and accreditation of Barangay Health Workers. In particular, it shall perform the following duties and responsibilities:

- 2a. Disseminate information or guidelines on the registration and accreditation of BHWs;
- 2b. Evaluate the registration and accreditation applications of BHWs and their supporting documents;
- 2c. Interview the applicant BHWs when deemed necessary;
- 2d. Deliberate and decide on the accreditation applications, and post the result of the deliberations;
- 2e. Issue Notice of Disapproval;
- 2f. Issue certificates of registration or accreditation;
- 2g. Keep a master list of registered and accredited BHWs; and
- 2h. Furnish copies of the registry of accredited BHWs to the Provincial Health Office and Department of Health.

Section 3. Meetings and Quorum. - The BHW-RAC shall meet at least once every quarter or as often as may be necessary. A majority of the members of the Committee shall constitute a quorum. Likewise, the affirmative vote of a majority of the Committee members shall be necessary to approve the applications.

Section 4. Compensation and Remuneration. - The chairperson, vice chairperson and members of the BHW-RAC shall perform their duties and responsibilities as such without compensation or remuneration.

Section 5. Repealing Clause. - All other orders, issuances and memoranda that are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 6. Effectivity. - This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
