RECONSTITUTING THE AFRICAN SWINE FEVER TASK FORCE (ASF-TF)

WHEREAS, the African Swine Fever (ASF) continues to spread in many countries and has entered the country causing social dislocation and massive economic losses to swine farmers;

WHEREAS, ASF may become widespread anywhere and reach a level that will require urgent, immediate and integrated action and response;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 02, Series of 2021, reorganized the African Swine Fever Task Force (ASF-TF) of the Municipality of Loon, and that there is a need to update the composition thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered and by virtue of the authority vested upon me under the Local Government Code and other existing laws, I, Elvi Peter L. Relampagos, mayor of the Municipality of Loon, Bohol, do hereby declare and order the following:

**Section 1. Composition.** - The African Swine Fever Task Force (ASF-TF) of the Municipality of Loon is hereby reconstituted, as follows:

**Section 2. Functions, Duties and Responsibilities.** - The ASF Task Force of the Municipality of Loon shall have the following functions, duties and responsibilities:

*2a. Information, Education and Communication*

2a1. Ensure adequate public awareness of the African Swine Fever and its status.

*2b. Quarantine*

2b1. Regulate the movement of animals, particularly swine; and

2b2. Conduct quarantine procedures for suspected and confirmed cases of ASF.

*2c. Surveillance and Monitoring*

2c1. Conduct surveillance and profiling of swine diseases in identified priority areas;

2c2. Man entry or exit points to check any possible illegal transport of swine;

2c3. Intensify monitoring of ports and submit pertinent reports immediately;


2c4. Submit regular updates on ASF-related activities to the Mun. Agriculture Office;

2c5. Carry out immediate diagnosis of suspected cases and implement stamping-out procedures as stated in the approved Provincial Preparedness and Contingency Plan; and

2c6. Take other preventive actions against ASF.

**Section 3. Effectivity.** - This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until expressly revoked.
