CREATING THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL FOR CULTURE

WHEREAS, a town's culture includes its history and the traditional and developing art forms of its people; and that it unifies the people of Loon as they strive to empower themselves to sustain their socioeconomic development;

WHEREAS, in order for the future generations to appreciate their own culture as a people, traditions in the arts need to be revived and preserved through research, cultural events, training, development of culture-based creative industries, and other developmental activities;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Loon recognizes that the tangible and intangible heritage and the creativity of the Loonanons are important components in charting the socioeconomic development of the town, and that these, whenever nurtured and enhanced, have potential for livelihood and revenue generation;

WHEREAS, there is a need for all concerned sectors to participate in programs and activities that highlight, preserve, enhance and disseminate culture;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council for Culture that was organized on April 22, 2020 needs to be reconstituted;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered and by virtue of the authority vested upon me under the Local Government Code and other existing laws, I, Elvi Peter L. Relampagos, mayor of the Municipality of Loon, Bohol, do hereby declare and order the following:
