**MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 24-010**

Series of 2024

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND PROPERLY IMPLEMENTING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10152, ENTITLED: "MANDATORY INFANTS AND CHILDREN HEALTH IMMUNIZATION ACT OF 2011" AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF**

**RATIONALE**

Republic Act No. 10152, otherwise known as the "Mandatory Infants and Children Health Immunization Act of 2011" was enacted to mandate the adoption of a comprehensive and sustainable immunization program for vaccine-preventable diseases for all Filipino children and infants.

The proper, efficient, and immediate implementation of the mandatory basic immunization for all infants and children in this Municipality shall be for the best interest of our constituency.

This implementation is to further support the availability of vaccines for our newborn, infants, and the entire public in general.

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** This ordinance shall be known and referred to as "An ordinance adopting and Properly Implementing Republic Act No. 10152, otherwise known as the "Mandatory Infants and Children Health Immunization Act of 2011".

**SECTION 2. SCOPE AND COVERAGE.** This ordinance shall cover the immunization of all infants and children for vaccine-preventable diseases in the Municipality of Loon, Bohol.

**SECTION 3. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES.** The following shall be the duties and responsibilities of:

1. All health care practitioners or health care workers who are administering prenatal care shall educate all pregnant mothers on the importance of giving their infants the basic immunization services as well as any possible effects if immunization;
2. Any physician, nurse, midwife, nursing aide, or skilled birth attendant, who delivers, or assists in the delivery of a newborn shall, prior to delivery, inform parents or legal guardian of the newborn of the availability, nature and benefits of immunization against Hepatitis B and other vaccine-preventable diseases at birth;
3. Rural Health Units of this Municipality with the assistance of the academe, professional societies, and non-government.

**SECTION 4. FREE MANDATORY BASIC IMMUNIZATION.** The mandatory basic immunization pursuant to this ordinance shall be given at the Rural Health Units and Birthing Centers of this Municipality to infants and children up to five (5) years of age.


**SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION.** The amount necessary to carry out the implementation of this ordinance shall be atleast Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 200,000.00) to be charged against the current year appropriation of the Municipal Health Unit. Thereafter, there shall be appropriated in the Municipal Health Unit for the continued implementation of this program.

**SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE.** Ordinances, rules and regulations of parts thereof, which are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


**SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
