MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 18-008
Series of 2018

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AND COMMEMORATING EVERY 22ND DAY OF JUNE AS THE FOUNDATION DAY OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LOON, PROVINCE OF BOHOL

Be it enacted by the 13th Sangguniang Bayan of Loon, Bohol in session duly assembled:

Section 1. DECLARATION. Every June 22 of each year is hereby declared as the Foundation Anniversary of the Municipality of Loon, Province of Bohol.

Section 2. RATIONALE. The annual commemoration of the Loon Foundation Day is pursuant to the findings of the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP) which declared that 22 June 1753 is the founding date of Loon.

Section 3. COUNCIL AND ITS FUNCTIONS.

3.1. There shall be created the Loon Foundation Day Council (LFDC) composed of the following:

- a) Mayor – Chairperson
- b) Vice Mayor – Vice Chairperson
- c) Members
 - All Members of the Sangguniang Bayan
 - Eight (8) District Presidents
 - Municipal Local Government Operations Officer
 - SB Secretary
 - Municipal Action Officer for Culture
 - Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator
 - Public Schools District Supervisor, DepEd- Loon North District
 - Public Schools District Supervisor, DepEd Loon South District
 - Kahugpungan sa Kababayen-ang Loonanon (KKL)
 - Heads of Departments/offices
 - Representatives of Socio-civic or sectoral organizations
 - Parish Priests of the Five Parishes of Loon

- President of Senior Citizens Association
- President, Loon Association of Municipal Employees
- Municipal Tourism Officer

3.2. Functions. The Loon Foundation Council shall perform the following functions:

- a) Serves as the lead committee for the success of the Foundation Day
- b) Perform their respective functions based on the following committee tasking:
 - 1. Committee on Program
 - 2. Committee on Venue, Sounds and Light
 - 3. Committee on Finance and Prizes
 - 4. Committee on the Search for Ten Most Outstanding Loonanons
 - 5. Committee on Loonanon Bar/Board Passers or Special Achievements
 - 6. Committee on Trade Fair and Exhibits
 - 7. Committee on the Search for Most Outstanding Barangay and Barangay Special Awards
 - 8. Committee on LGU Performance Report
 - 9. Committee on Security and Order
 - 10. Oversight Committee

Section 4. PROGRAM OF ACTIVITIES. The program of activities during the Foundation Day shall be prepared to include, among others, the following:

- a) LGU Performance Report;
- b) Awarding of Ten Most Outstanding Loonanons;
- c) Recognition of Loonanon Achievers such as Topnotchers, Board and Bar Passers and Special Achievements;
- d) Awarding of Most Outstanding Barangay;
- e) Barangay Special Awards;
- f) Agri-industry and trade fair;
- g) Artistic and other socio-cultural exhibits/presentations;
- h) Other activities approved by the Council.

Section 5. MOST OUTSTANDING BARANGAY.

5.1. Criteria. There shall be awarded Most Outstanding Barangay of Loon based on the following criteria:

- a) Barangay Peace & Order System – 20%
- b) Barangay Local Governance – 20%
- c) Barangay Greening Program – 20%
- d) Health and Sanitation – 20%
- e) Purok Management System – 20%

5.2. Special Awards. There shall be allocated funds and prizes for special awards to any barangay who topped in any field, among others, as follows:

- 1. Best in Peace & Order
- 2. Best in Comprehensive Barangay Development Plan
- 3. Best in Barangay Records Management
- 4. Best in Barangay Fruits for our Future Project (F3P)
- 5. Best in Barangay Pocket Forest
- 6. Best in Barangay Eco-Tourism
- 7. Best in Barangay Backyard Gardening System
- 8. Best in Barangay Solid and Liquid Waste Management System
- 9. Best in Barangay Anti-Rabies Implementation System
- 10. Best Barangay Hall

11. Best Purok System
12. Best Day Care Center

5.3. Procedures. The Search for Most Outstanding Barangay shall undergo the following procedures.

1. In the spirit of Legislative Tracking and Executive – Legislative Coordination, the Search for Most Outstanding Barangay shall be an output of consolidation of official evaluation per LGU office supervision and management.
2. The following offices shall receive Performance Report, personally authenticate, inspect and verify the same in the respective field areas with audio-visual documentations and proofs, as follows:

The process and mechanics of selection shall be formulated by the Search Committee and to be approved by the Foundation Council.

Section 6. SELECTION OF OUTSTANDING LOONANONS.

6.1. Recognition. There shall be awarded "Ten Most Outstanding Loonanons" in the following field of specializations:

1. Public/ Government service
2. Religious vocation/ service
3. Professional Services such as medical, legal, engineering and other professions
4. Education
5. Agricultural production
6. Business
7. Eco-Tourism
8. Culture such as virtues inculturation, literary arts, visual arts and performing arts
9. Sports
10. Family life

6.2. Criteria. The Search for Most Outstanding Loonanon per field shall be based on the following criteria as determined by the Search Committee and the Council:

1. Level of Excellence- such as degree of performance and being a model to a community
2. Impact on Loonanons - such as socio-economic enhancement to the Loonanon Community, development/nurturing of values by example, development of local pride

6.3. Procedures. The procedures in the Search for Most Outstanding Loonanons shall be as follows:

1. Each of the 10 fields of service specializations shall be considered as one (1) sector, such as: government/public, religious, professional education/academe, agriculture, business, eco-tourism, culture, sports, and family.
2. Each sector or any credible number of the affected sector may nominate its Most Outstanding Loonanons to a maximum of five (5) per sector with supporting documents or proof of performance and achievements for the previous year from January to December.
3. The Search Committee shall consolidate all the nominations and shall choose only five (5) semi-finalists per field.
4. The Council shall choose three (3) finalists per field.
5. There shall be Board of Judges per category who are persons of high degree of competence, independence and integrity and who shall choose who among the finalists be declared the Ten (10) Most Outstanding Loonanons.
6. The nomination and selection forms shall be prepared and distributed by the Search Committee.

Section 7. LOONANON ACHIEVERS.

- a) Loonanons who passed or topped the licensure or bar examinations within the period from June of the preceding year until May of the current year shall automatically be awarded as Academic Achievers.
- b) Loonanons who excelled in other fields
- c) Residences, domicile, date of examination and release, and academic records or exemplary achievements in other fields shall be attached to form part of the records of the Search Committee.

Section 8. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated an amount of at least Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P 500,000.00) for every year's activity.

Section 9. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect after posting copies thereof at the public buildings of the municipality and at the entrance of the sixty seven (67) barangay halls of Loon for a period of at least fifteen (15) days.
