MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 22-009
Series of 2022

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING BURIAL AID AT A MINIMUM OF FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (P 5,000.00) FOR EACH DECEASED BONAFIDE RESIDENT, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE BURIAL AID ORDINANCE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LOON, PROVINCE OF BOHOL

RATIONALE

The enactment of this ordinance is founded on the most logical necessity to allocate funds for Loonanon constituents who needed most of financial assistance especially in trying times. This act may lessen the financial burden of the striving families.

Be it enacted by the 14th Sangguniang Bayan of Loon, Bohol in session duly assembled:

Section 1. SCOPE. The scope of this ordinance covers any deceased bonafide resident of Loon represented by the bereaved family who seeks financial assistance for burial from the Local Government Unit of Loon.

Section 2. OBJECTIVES. This ordinance is enacted to serve the following objectives:

- 1. To address the pressing financial needs of Loonanon constituents especially on burial expenses.
- 2. To ensure that every family of the town can rely on the Local Government Unit for support of financial assistance in crisis situations.

Section 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS.

- 1. Financial assistance official help given to a person or organization in form of money, loans, reduced taxes, etc.
- 2. Burial assistance refers to the assistance to the bereaved family for payment of funeral expenses incurred and transfer of cadaver of a deceased person from one place to another.
- 3. Crisis situation pertains to a condition whereby an individual or group of persons are faced with a different and stressful situation resulting to the impairment of his/her psychosocial functioning thereby needing series of interventions to prevent further exposure to vulnerabilities, exploitation and abuse.

Section 4. GENERAL POLICIES. The financial assistance to be given shall be governed by the following rules:

- 1. The certain deceased individual represented by the family who will ask for financial aid must be a bonafide resident of the Municipality of Loon.
- 2. The family of the deceased shall receive a minimum of Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) as burial assistance.

Section 5. REQUIREMENTS. The clients seeking assistance shall bring and submit the following original or certified true copy of documents to the authorized personnel of the DSWD:

- 1. Death certificate of the deceased
- 2. Barangay Clearance/Certificate of Residency subject to validation with the Unified Database of all Inhabitants of Loon at MSWDO as per MO No. 009-2021 series of 2021

Section 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any provision inconsistent thereto is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
