MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 03-003 Series of 2003

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING WAYS FOR CARING DOGS AND CONTROLLING ITS POPULATION, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "DOGS CONTROL ORDINANCE"-

"WHEREAS, dogs are most loved animals but carry worst danger when we will be bitten;

"WHEREAS, dogs are found everywhere that plenty are no longer taken cared of by owners thus its vaccination cannot be assured;

"WHEREAS, though dogs are vaccinated but when people are bitten they still worried about rabbies hence will cause them so much worries and will surely affect their health mentally and physically;

"WHEREAS, there is a need to control dogs population through proper coordination with barangay officials who will execute its implementation;

"NOW, THEREFORE, premises considered, be it enacted by the 8th Sangguniang Bayan assembled:

SECTION 1. Title – AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING WAYS FOR CARING DOGS AND CONTROLLING ITS POPULATION, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "DOGS CONTROL ORDINANCE."

SECTION 2. Provisions

SB MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 03-004, Series of 2003

2.1 Caring of Dogs – In addition to food and water supply, dogs must be regularly bathed and annually be vaccinated as provided for in Section 2.1 of Ordinance No. 6, series of 1998.

2.2 Control of population of dogs – All male dogs must be castrated. Those dogs which are not castrated because of its intention for reproduction will be required to have it registered with the barangay and pay P100.00 as annual registration fee.

2.3 Responsibilities of Handling Dogs – Any liabilities and damages arising from dogs shall be the responsibilities of the owner.

SECTION 3. Rules and Guides to owner and Barangay Officials;

3.1 All dogs must be registered with the barangay and the barangay officials are mandated for its inspection and control (recording).

3.2 Owners of dogs in excess of two must be required to pay an annual fee of P50.00 per dog in the concerned barangay.

3.3 Dog owners shall be responsible to pay for medication of the victim, and to pay for whatever damages, accruing hereto. The barangay official shall cause the recording of the incident being reported by the victim or his family.

SECTION 4. Penal Clause – Any violation of this ordinance shall be fined as follows:

 $\begin{array}{l} P200.00-1^{st} \mbox{ offense} \\ P500.00-2^{nd} \mbox{ offense} \\ P500.00 \ \& \ 1 \ month \ imprisonment \ or \ both - 3^{rd} \ offense \end{array}$

SECTION 5. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and due publication.
